OVER
60 special needs
individuals-
newborns, children,
and young adults:

- **Shalva Center for Special Needs** - Assisted 30 preschool age children.
- **Yachad Mentoring Program** - Mentored Yachad members and had dinner dates with their Yachad buddy each week.
- **Yachad Hub** - Taught cooking and other life skills to 20 Yachad young adults.
- **Families in the RBS Community** - Cared for special needs children (down syndrome, cp, autistic, and blind) and their siblings in a family setting.

OVER
50 families from the RBS
community including:

- **Families Facing Medical Challenges** - Helped families facing cancer, leukemia, heart disease, brain tumor and broken bone disease.
- **Single Parent Families**

IDF SOLDIERS

Tiferet made and packaged thousands of food packages and treats for our Chayalim in Gaza and prepared hundreds of IDF Dri-Fit shirts for Tzitzit. Additionally, we hosted Carnivals, a Dance Party and Karaoke evening, Ceramic Painting, Toy Drive, Zumba and much more for the traumatized young women and children evacuated from communities attacked on October 7.

TIFERET EMERGENCY CHESED HELP

Students volunteered their free time to help families dealing with unexpected crises. Whether it was a medical crisis or a tragedy, Tiferet students were always happy to help in any way they can.

ADOPT A BUBBY

Visited the elderly during dinner time, participated in Rosh Chodesh, Purim, and Shavuot parties and presented shiurim.

YACHAD / TIFERET EVENTS

Tiferet hosted Yachad members for a beautiful challah bake, a fun Chanuka dance party, and an exercise class.

MELABEV

Students created and won a prize for a game they designed to help individuals facing cognitive decline and dementia. Tiferet was mentioned for this accomplishment in the Israeli magazine Dorot.

EZER MITZION BAKING EXTRAVAGANZA

Students baked over 600 slices of cake in the Ezer Mitzion pastry kitchen that was distributed to sick patients in the hospital.

NEVE MICHAEL BAT MITZVAH AND CARNIVAL

Tiferet partnered with the Neve Michael Children's Village to provide two extraordinary events: a Purim Carnival and a Bat Mitzvah. Neve Michael is a home for children who have suffered from neglect, violence and/or abuse in their homes. Many of these girls were never given a Bat Mitzvah. Tiferet made them feel special by creating a Bat Mitzvah celebration that they will remember and cherish for the rest of their lives.

DARKAYNU SHABBATON

Tiferet hosted the amazing students of Midreshet Darkaynu, a seminary for young women with special needs for a Shabbat at Tiferet with meals in our teachers' homes, shiurim and fun programs.

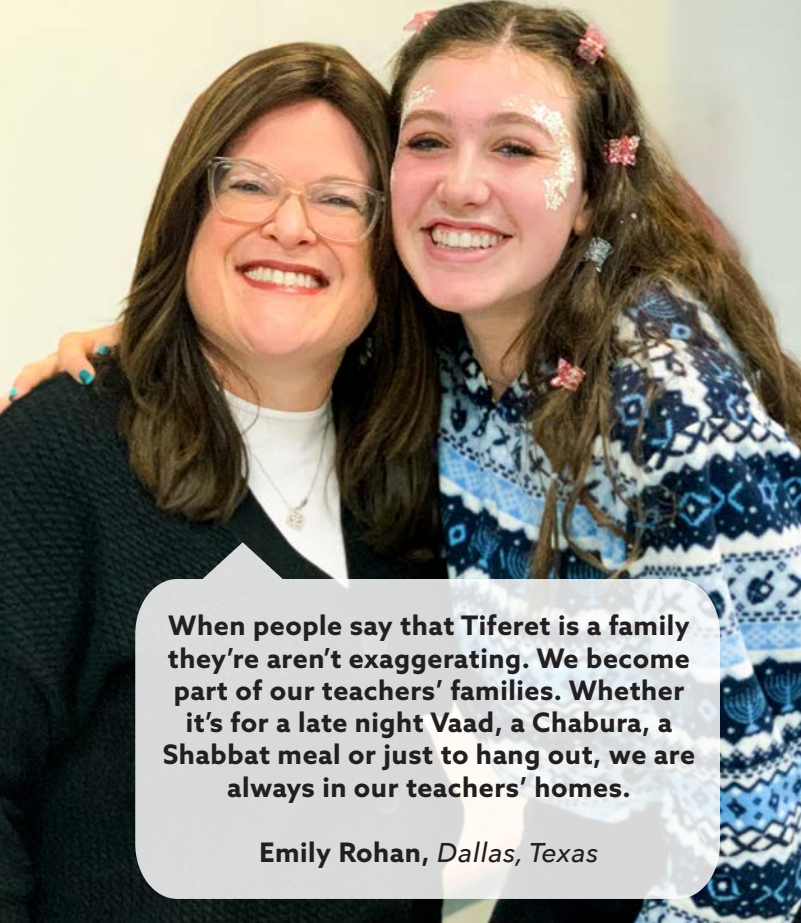

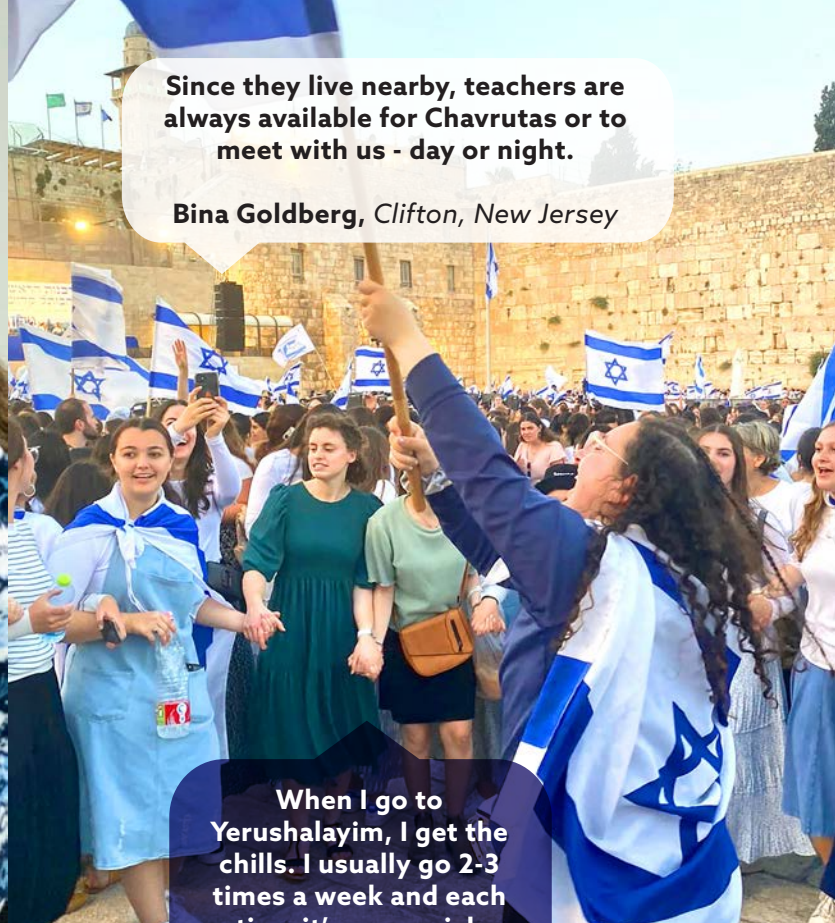
